France 2026

Once again, we are delighted to be able to offer the opportunity for Year 6 children to attend a five-day residential in France. The trip provides a unique experience, allowing children to broaden their cultural horizons and put into practice the French learned throughout KS2. Previous trips have been outstanding, providing children with opportunities to visit local towns, French markets, beautiful beaches and a chance to experience a range of outdoor pursuits. We hope to return next year to 'Chateau Adventure,' at **Le Chateau du Broutel, Rue, France.**

The proposed date is **Monday 18th May – Friday 22nd May 2026**. The total cost for the trip will be **£696.00** – this includes all coach and ferry travel, four nights / five days full board and **all activities**. **£690.00** will be paid via parent pay and **£6** cash needs to be paid directly to the school to pay for museum entry.

Another **£22** is required for breakfast going out (£10)/evening meal on the return journey (£12) and **30** Euros pocket money.

The interest slip will be required by Friday 19th September 2025. A non-refundable deposit of £100.00 will be required by Friday 17th October 2025 to secure your place. Your child's place will only be confirmed after we have received the deposit. Anyone requesting a place after this date cannot be guaranteed one. A call to France will need to be made. **A second non-refundable deposit of £50.00 will be required by Friday 12th December 2025 and the remaining balance will need to be paid by Monday 9th March 2026.**

The Trust would like to make this trip accessible to all families. Please, if the reason for your child not going is purely financial speak to the appropriate Head Teacher who will be able to put help into place. Any discussions will be treated confidentially. We are also looking at fundraising options and the total cost of the trip might be reduced.

All children will need to have their **own passport** for this journey, **all passports must be valid until the end of December 2026**. **GHIC cards** are also required. Both will be required in school by **Friday 1st May 2026**.

Previous year's journeys have certainly provided value for money and a real French experience. It is something that the children will remember for the rest of their lives! We have photos of past residentials that can be viewed if you wish; even children who were initially nervous of being away from home came along and thoroughly enjoyed it - many asked to stay even longer!
